A girl without a health exam form will not be able to go. Photocopy her health history, health exam form, and your permission form to include with her 10-essentials!

# **MANDATORY PARENTS MEETING**

Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, is a mandatory meeting for camper and parent at 7:00 p.m. at Camp Eucalyptus, 641 California Street in El Segundo. Street parking is available. You will be placed in new patrols and have your first patrol meeting, with two more patrol meetings to be scheduled by your MISC before we leave for the desert.

### TRAVEL PLANS

Campers will leave from Columbia Park on Prairie at 190<sup>th</sup> Street, on Thursday morning, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Plan to be at the park at 6:00 a.m., the bus will leave at 6:30 a.m. sharp. (The bus waits for no one.) Campers should wear their sun hat, patrol scarves, whistles and hiking boots on the bus. They should carry a daypack with lunch and a full water bottle, ten essentials, hammer/work gloves and any medication. Bring lunch money (\$10.00) for stopping on the return trip on Monday, April 8<sup>th</sup>. Campers will travel on a bus with Mojave adult chaperones.

### **RETURN PLANS**

We will return to the Prairie Ave parking lot at Columbia Park, 190<sup>th</sup> & Prairie Ave. We expect to arrive between 6:00 and 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 8<sup>th</sup>. You will receive a phone call from our emergency contacts as to when the bus is expected to arrive. We need parents to help unload the truck at our storage location afterwards!

### GEAR

Hiking boots are a must! Well-fitting comfortable boots are critical. They will be worn during all camp activities.

Patrol and personal gear, including tents, firewood, and empty backpack frames, must be put on the truck at Columbia Park, Prairie Avenue at 190<sup>th</sup> Street, on Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, between 6 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Gear should be well packed, and labeled with girl's name and patrol fabric strips. No wheeled luggage! Girls must be able to carry their own gear. Backpacks must be in a large plastic trash bag and labeled. Wood (2x4 pieces, no nails or paint, no logs and not pressure treated) should be packed in boxes with lids or in gunny sacks (feed sacks).

All patrol gear and personal gear MUST be put on the truck - NO EXCEPTIONS! There is an uphill hike from the bus to main camp so girls should only bring their daypack and lunch on the bus. We need parents to help load the truck Tuesday evening at Columbia Park!!

Backpacker meeting is Saturday, March 23rd, at 7:00 p.m. at Camp Eucalyptus, 641 California Street, El Segundo. You must bring at least one parent. Your presence is required so the overnight hike will be a pleasant experience. We will discuss gear and packing and how a pack should fit you.
